Community Care Alliance of Illinois (CCAI) is a not-for-profit, wholly owned subsidiary of Family Health Network, a Medicaid managed care plan for almost 20 years. CCAI was formed in response to Illinois's Medicaid reform law that requires that by 2014 at least fifty percent of individuals covered under Medicaid be enrolled in a care coordination program. CCAI is dedicated to providing comprehensive person-centered care locally for the Medicaid population, and specialize in the care of Seniors and People with Disabilities.

History and Partners

Founded in 1995, Family Health Network is a not-for-profit safety net provider sponsored Managed Care Community Network in the state of Illinois.

Seeking a better alternative for Medicaid health care and financing, Family Health Network joined with the following allies to develop CCAI.

- Access Living of Metropolitan Chicago, a nationally recognized advocacy group for people with disabilities.
- Health & Medicine Policy Research Group, an independent policy center that conducts research, educates and collaborates with other groups to advocate policies and impact health systems to improve the health status of all people.
- Sinai Health System and Schwab Rehabilitation Hospital recognized as a national model for urban health care delivery.
